**SUSAN JACKSON** received the Bay Area Theatre Critics Circle Award for Best Original Play. Her works have been staged- read/produced in New York City, the Bay Area, Eugene O'Neill Foundation, and abroad. Finalist/semi-finalist: Fusion Theatre Company, Creede Repertory Theatre, South Carolina Centre Stage, Little Black Dress Ink Women's Theatre Festival. *SAMARITAN*--finalist for the Henley Rose Competition-Female Playwrights. 2018—2021: Finalist for the 3Girls Theatre Festival. *DEATH BE NOT LOUD!*--Best of Capital Fringe with Washington Post positive review and TBA recommended. **ELIZABETH APPELL** is a playwright, screenwriter, novelist, and filmmaker. Her full-length plays have been given directed readings in New York, Los Angeles, and San Francisco. *Confessions of a Catholic Child* was first produced in Los Angeles and then went up at The EXIT Theatre, San Francisco. Two of Appell's plays have placed as semifinalist in the prestigious Eugene O'Neil Playwriting Conference. Appell's two short films *Easy Made Hard* and *Warnings from the Bathtub*, starring the late iconic Karen Black were official selections at over 30 festivals and both were awarded Gold in Houston. Easy Made Hard was screened at the Short Film Corner in Cannes.



**ROBIN BRADFORD** is an award-winning playwright and screenwriter, whose work has been performed in New York, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Detroit, Wilmington, Washington, Pittsburgh, and more. She's produced two feature films, *Graduation* (a favorite on the film festival circuit) and *Frank*, the story of a boy and a dog, as well as several short films. She's sold numerous scripts to studios and a screenplay was picked up for production at Berlinale 2019.



**VICTORIA ERVILLE** Ms. Evans Erville's play, *Lies That Bind* was a semifinalist in the Bay Area Playwrights Festival 2019. Her short plays A *Mother's Heart* received a staged reading at the 2019 Women's Theatre Festival of N.C. and *The Test*, at Piano Fight's Shortlived 8 Festival (week 8 – second place). Ms Evans Erville is a 2019-2020 pool writer for Playground Theatre, a Brady Fellow with 3Girls Theatre and a Dramatist Guild member.



**LINDA AYERS-FREDERICK** is Phoenix Theatre's Artistic Director since 1985 (www.phoenixtheatresf.org), two- time Shubert Playwriting Fellow, 3Girls Salon Playwright, AEA SAG/AFTRA actor, director, producer, critic VP SFBATCC. Her plays have received over 20 productions with numerous Awards and have been performed in NYC, Edinburgh, France, Alaska and the Bay Area. She has acted in over 100 plays professionally.



**LEE BRADY** an award-winning San Francisco playwright who, like everyone else in theatre, wears several hats. She's an actor (*Gin Game* in Antigua, Guatemala), *The Oldest Profession*, in San Francisco, CA. She is a founder/resident playwright for 3Girls Theatre (3girlstheatre.org), a teacher of playwriting (Monterey Peninsula College), and a theatre critic (Pacific Sun Newspaper). But writing plays is her first love and seeing them produced is her biggest thrill. Her plays have been produced in Memphis, New York City, Columbia, Missouri, Edinburgh, Scotland and Valdez and Alaska as well as in San Francisco.

Her latest play, Southern Lights, was produced at Z Below theater in San Francisco (just before the pandemic!).



**KAREN CARONNA** is a San Francisco Bay Area writer and actor, honored and proud to be a Brady Fellow, with 3Girls Theater. My play, *The Next to the Last Box* was scheduled for the Salon Series season 2019-2020, before it succumbed to COVID, second season lucky! I have had short plays produced locally, including the NARAL Repro Rights play festival, 2017, and other short plays with Playwright's Center of San Francisco, as well as Stagebridge, Oakland. I have had poetry published in Rat's Ass Review, and other publications. A California native, my home is in Oakland.



ELIZABETH GJELTEN 's full-length produced plays include *Hunter's Point* (St. Boniface Church Theater, Bay Area Playwrights Festival), *What the Birds Carry* (Pear Avenue Theatre), and *Dance Lessons* (Venue 9, Working Woman Festival). She has also had several short plays and solo pieces performed at venues around the Bay Area and beyond, including *Big Breath*, produced as part of Alleyway Theatre's Digital Theatre Festival in 2020. *Big Breath* was selected for the 2021 anthology, The Best 10-Minute Plays (Smith & Kraus Publishers). Awards include selection as an Artist Investigator with California Shakespeare Theatre's Triangle Project, the Rainin Foundation's Honorary Fellowship at the Djerassi Resident Artists Program, and Theatre Bay Area's TITAN Award. Gjelten has taught at SFSU, New College of California, JFK University, and juvenile detention facilities. She has also designed and led community/arts engagement projects with current and former unhoused women and organizations that serve them, including *Everyone Deserves a Home*, funded by the California Humanities Council. She has an MFA in playwriting from SFSU and was a longtime student of poetics with Diane di Prima.



**JENNIFER ROBERTS** is a Vallejo-based playwright and producer with an MFA in creative writing from CCA. She's a 3GT playwright, a 2018 3GT Brady Fellow, and was Lead Artist for 3GT Investigates: Birth Rights, as well as co-founder and producer of Repro Rights! Her work has been seen in Chicago, Seattle, Ohio, New York, and throughout the Bay Area.



## **ELIZABETH FLANAGAN** is a Salon Series playwright with 3Girls

Theatre, a member of the PlayGround Writer's Company and The Stranger Playwright's Collective, a co-founder of Ex Nihilo Theater, and previously served on the board of the Playwrights' Center of San Francisco.
