About the Play

What if our actions affected the past as well as the future? A man and a woman living centuries apart in the same flat gradually become aware of one another. A mysterious sexual charge permeates their work and their sleep, driving them to distraction and inspiration. Set in the ever-shifting London of today and yesterday, "Today I Live" is a story of immigration, transformation and blended identities.

About the Playwright

Susan-Jane Harrison is a British-American Playwright and Performer - and a recognized Voice and Performance Coach (SJ Harrison). Internationally awarded for her work as actor and playwright, she trained at The Royal Academy of Dramatic Art in London and has an MFA from UC Davis. Unusual collaborations in Harrison's artistic work have allowed her to develop across disciplines. Her development of the Inhabiting Technique, a complete physical, intellectual and emotional system for actors resulted in academic publication of her performance research. Her first play "Alaska" was produced on BBC Radio, with (the now Sir) Michael Sheen in the title role. An earlier version of Today I Live was produced at the RADA Festival in London in 2016.


