About the Play

In a futuristic version of our world, touch of any kind is illegal unless specifically consensual. But the rules around this are as ever, contradictory. Originally written for radio in 2013, Susan-Jane Harrison's *Touched* is a surprisingly pre-cognitive examination of social distance, isolation and fear of contact. A scientist and an anthropologist, unknown to each other and living in the same apartment building, act on their longing for contact in two very different ways, leading them to a dramatic face to face encounter.

About the Playwright

Susan-Jane Harrison is a British-American Playwright and Performer - and a recognized Voice and Performance Coach (SJ Harrison). Internationally awarded for her work as actor and playwright, she trained at The Royal Academy of Dramatic Art in London and has an MFA from UC Davis. Unusual collaborations in Harrison's artistic work have allowed her to develop across disciplines. Her development of the Inhabiting Technique, a complete physical, intellectual and emotional system for actors resulted in academic publication of her performance research. Her first play "Alaska" was produced on BBC Radio, with (the now Sir) Michael Sheen in the title role.

We're proud to be one of the very few theatre companies in the nation that develop and present only plays written by women, trans, and nonbinary playwrights.
